Materials are printed in the editor in **Word 2007, 2010**, font: **Times New Roman font 10pt, 0.7** paragraph indentation; line spacing "**single**", alignment "**in width**" in **A5** format (*File* → *Page settings* → "*Paper size*" tab → *select A5 format*), all fields are **2.0 cm**.

Formulas in the text are typed in **Microsoft Equation**.

Drawings, diagrams, diagrams should be clear (photos are not accepted).

The list of literature is placed at the end of the text and separated by an empty line.

The bibliography in abstracts should not exceed three or four titles. References to the literature in the text should be given by numbering in square brackets [1], [2].
